

### **Key Findings of the CHO Phone Survey for the State of Nagaland**

In Nagaland, call was made to two CHOs as per the data available of which survey was successfully completed for one. Key findings are:

- The CHO had completed the 6-month training in IGNOU Certificate Programme in Community Health and has B.Sc. Nursing background.
- The facility has already been upgraded to HWC and has been providing services related to NCDs.
- The training of the Primary Care was completed for all the ASHAs and MPWs posted at the HWC.
- With the IT infrastructure in place, the CBAC filling has been started at the facility, however, the CHO did not have idea about population enumeration.
- Screening has been started for hypertension, diabetes, breast and oral cancer.
- The availability of medicines for Hypertension and Diabetes was there at the facility.
- Among the essential point of care diagnostics, the facility was conducting test for haemoglobin, Urine Pregnancy Rapid Test, Urine Dipstick-Urine Albumin and Sugar, Blood Glucose (through glucometer), RDK for Malaria, Dengue and Sickle Cell.
- The facility also had the provision for collection of Sputum Sample.
